Using Sunrise Record Manager (SRM) Stations after ICD-10 Implementation

Types of Station in SRM

1. SmartDate Option

- SRM will automatically recognize the Discharge Date for patient and will automatically choose whether to use ICD9 or ICD10 coding
- Most coders will use this option

2. Manual Option

- If there is a payer that is not ready for ICD10 yet, coders can choose this special station to code cases in ICD9 even if the date is after 10/1/2015

3. Dual Code Option

- Already in use, but coders can still choose this station after 10/1/2015
 - Probably very coders that will use it

SmartDate Option (Current Abstract station)

Code set dependent on discharge date

- This station will open either ICD9 or ICD10 depending on the discharge date
 - Visits with discharge date before 10/1/2015 will default to ICD9
 - Visits with discharge date on or after 10/1/2015 will default to ICD10
- Current abstract station has this setup

SmartDate Option (Current Abstract station)

will default to ICD9 on visits that have a discharge date before 10/1/2015

Discharge date 9/29/2015 → SRM and Encoder default to ICD9

SmartDate Option (Current Abstract station)

- If the user wants to use a specific code set, they can always choose by selecting the appropriate radio button
- No matter what station the user is in-they will always have the option to choose the code set they want to use by selecting the appropriate radio button

Manual Option (ICD9 Abstract station)

No matter what the discharge date is, SRM and Encoder will always default to ICD9.




Manual Option (ICD9 Abstract station)

Important to note that even though this station is for ICD9 use only, users can use ICD10 if they wish to do so.

They just have to select the ICD10 radio button in SRM.

Dual Code Station (currently used)

- Will use the discharge date to determine whether to use ICD10 or ICD9
 - Visits with discharge date before 10/1/2015 will default to ICD9
 - Visits with discharge date on or after 10/1/2015 will default to ICD10
- Users can manually choose which code set they would like to use if they do not want to use the default

Dual Code Station

will work the same as Abstract station- discharge date will determine if ICD9 or ICD10 will be the primary

Discharge date is 9/29/2015 → ICD9 is default
